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INSTRUCTIONS AFTER INSERTION OF MIDDLE EAR VENTILATING TUBES

- 1. Diet and activity should be determined by how the patient feels. Most children should be able to return to normal activities within a few hours.
- 2. Drainage from the ear canal, including slight bleeding, is commonly seen for 1-2 days after the tubes are put in. If drainage persists beyond 1-2 days, please call the surgeon's office at (309) 268-3200. Treatment for the drainage will be ordered over the telephone.
- 3. Do **NOT** use Q-tips at any time.
- 4. Keep the ear canals dry. When bathing or washing hair, insert ear plugs into the ear canals. These are available through our office.
- 5. The surgery is usually NOT painful. However, if an earache occurs, you may give a dose of your regular pain medicine.
- 6. The tubes remain in the ear drum for a period of 3 months to 2 years; the average time is 6-12 months. You may not know when they come out.
- 7. Please keep your scheduled post-operative appointment and see your surgeon every few months as directed.
